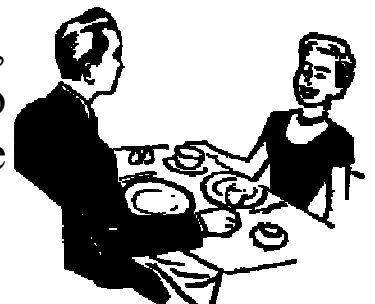

The month of August has been quite unique. The dry spell we have been under has been somewhat stressful to the golf course. The dry spell along with the extreme hot and humid weather during the months of July and August has made us rely solely on the irrigation system to water the golf course. This irrigation water has high levels of sodium and bicarbonates which has caused the burning of the turfgrass. September brings fall aerification; as soon as the Iowa Wife/Husband event is completed we will begin our fall aerification program. We will deep-tine aerify and heavily sand topdress the greens on September 12<sup>th</sup>. The aerification has many benefits and one of those benefits from deep-tine aerification is that it will help loosen our compacted clay subsoil. The sand topdressing will help with drainage and make it easier for the root system of the turfgrass to become stronger. We will also be aerifying the tees and fairways around that same week.

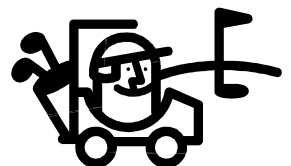
